



* INTRODUCTION *

In August 1996 I met Fereydoun Kia at a course that I was giving titled "Seduction of Spirit." We are both lovers of the poems of Jalāl al-Dīn Mohammad Balkhi (popularly known as Rumi) and during that week of spiritual rhapsody we spent many moments exulting in the ravishing ecstasy that the passion of Rumi evoked in both of us.

One day Fereydoun introduced us to a Rumi love song that he had translated into English. That evening a woman from the course performed an ecstatic dervish dance while I recited the poem in English, as a friend of ours played music to her movements. Suddenly, the idea was born: "Let's do a new translation of love poems by Rumi that evoke both the agony and ecstasy of yearning."

These poems reflect the deepest longings of the human heart as it searches for the divine. They celebrate love. Each poetic whisper is urgent, expressing the desire that penetrates human relationships and inspires intimacy with the self, silently nurturing an affinity for the Beloved. They are not direct translations, but "moods" that we have captured as certain phrases radiated from the original Farsi, giving life to a new creation but retaining the essence of its source.

Both Fereydoun and I hope that they will give you a glimpse of that beautiful world of love that we experienced as we sought to capture in English the dreams, wishes, hopes, desires, and feelings of a man who continues to amaze, bewilder, confound, and teach one thousand years after he walked on this earth.
